Main Impact / Outcomes of My Study Abroad Experience

Prior to starting my experience abroad, I set goals related to personal growth and career advancement such as improving my skillset, adjusting and solidifying my values and beliefs, and gaining international exposure to become a more global minded thinker. I was able to meet all the goals despite the shortened time due to the pandemic.

Course-related trips was a major component of my abroad program.
